#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Membership in the Jointly-Contributory Retirement System for Employees of the Sea and Shore Fisheries Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 60, § 5, sub-§ VI, additional. Section 5 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered VI, to read as follows:
- 'VI. Any warden of the department of sea and shore fisheries who is a member of this system and who has creditable service of at least 25 years may be retired at  $\frac{1}{2}$  of his average final compensation provided such retirement is requested either by the member or commissioner. If any such member should become eligible under the provisions of this system as a result of prior service and membership service, to a retirement allowance in excess of  $\frac{1}{2}$  of his average final compensation, he shall be entitled to the higher retirement allowance.'
