AN ACT Relating to Fees of Trial Justices in Certain Parts of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1943, c. 70, amended. Chapter 70 of the private and special laws of 1943 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘Such trial justices shall not be entitled to any fees or costs as set forth in section 22 of chapter 97 of the revised statutes, but such fees and costs shall be payable to the county of Aroostook and each of such trial justices shall receive an annual salary of \$1,000 to be paid by the county of Aroostook.’
