STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Designating a Portion of State Route No. 139 as a State Highway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Portion of state route No. 139 designated as state highway. The road leading from Benton to Unity, being a portion of state route No. 139, from the point at which it digresses from state route No. 100, in said Benton, to the point at which it merges with state route No. 9, in said Unity, be, and hereby is, designated a state highway; and the state highway commission is hereby directed forthwith to put and maintain the same in good condition.
