**AN ACT Regulating Handling of Animals Seized by
Humane Agents.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 127, § 22-A, additional. Chapter 127 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 22-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 22-A. Handling of animals seized by humane agent, regulated. No person acting under authority of a state humane agent shall sell, breed or trade animals coming into their possession by reason of office, or shall provide or supply dealers, commercial kennels or laboratories with such animals.

Livestock to be sold at public auction shall be exempted from the provisions of this section.'
