STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Military Expenses.

Appropriating moneys for military expenses. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$500,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948, and the sum of \$500,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949, to continue program of armory construction and maintenance; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the provisions of chapter 120 of the resolves of 1939, as far as applicable, shall apply to this resolve; and be it further

RESOLVED: That any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This money is needed to continue Military Defense Commission's program for construction of armories and to cooperate with the federal government and Maine cities and towns on additional armory projects. There are projects already voted on for which funds have been obligated.
