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**AN ACT to Enforce Unfair Sales Practices in Cigarettes.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 170, § 5-A, additional.** Chapter 170 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 5-A, to read as follows:

**Sec. 5-A. Sale of cigarettes.** The state tax assessor shall enforce the provisions of this chapter so far as they apply to the sale of cigarettes and may suspend or revoke the license of any dealer or distributor who violates any of the provisions of this chapter in the sale of cigarettes. The provisions of sections 201 and 202 of chapter 14 shall apply to the provisions of this section.'
