STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for Maintenance of a Road in the Town of Lamoine.

Maintenance of road in Lamoine. Resolved: That the state highway commission is hereby authorized and directed to expend on the road, in the town of Lamoine, as much as shall be deemed necessary for its maintenance, but not to exceed \$500 a year, beginning at the Douglas highway at a point approximately .8 of a mile from the easterly end of said highway, and extending through the state-owned property, formerly known as the U. S. Coal Depot, to the wharf and buildings at the shore; and be it further

Resolved: That the funds so expended shall be taken from any funds available for maintenance of state and state aid highways.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve is to authorize the state highway commission to expend as much money as shall be deemed necessary but not to exceed \$500 for maintenance and repair of a road in Lamoine.
