IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to Mrs. Lucy Nickols, of Lewiston.

Mrs. Lucy Nickols; pension for. Resolved: That a pension of \$10 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Mrs. Lucy Nickols, of Lewiston, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1947 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Nickols is a widow and has a 12 year old boy to care for. He is blind and is in an institution. Mrs. Nickols is 95% blind herself and is unable to find work. She is being evicted from her apartment and has no place to go. She is now receiving a pension for the blind of \$40 per month which is insufficient to care for herself and her son's needs.
