IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Persons Handling Food.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 88, § 51-A, additional. Chapter 88 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 51-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 51-A. Health certificate of persons handling food. All persons employed in the handling of food, whether to be canned or served to the public, shall obtain a health certificate. Such certificate shall be renewed at least every 3 months. The provisions of this section shall not apply to housewives.'
