**AN ACT Exempting Certain Independent Contractors from the Regulations
in re Motor Vehicles Used in Intrastate Traffic.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 44, § 27, sub-§ I, ¶ I, additional. Subsection I of section 27 of chapter 44 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, to be lettered I, to read as follows:

'I. Of any independent contractor transporting agricultural products or farm supplies, exclusively, for 1 or more owners or operators of farms.'
