**RESOLVE, in Favor of William Reardon, of Sullivan.**

**William Reardon; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$100 to be paid to William Reardon, of Sullivan, as a refund of the fee which he paid for a retail malt liquor license issued to him and which he did not use; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.
