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**RESOLVE, Closing Tributaries to Moose River to All Fishing.**

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**Tributaries to Moose river; closed to fishing. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to close to all fishing all tributaries to Moose river beginning at the Franklin-Somerset county line and continuing to Brassua lake, except Holeb stream, Barret brook, Wood stream, Sandy stream, Heald stream, Little Churchill, Big Churchill, Parlin stream, but including Mountain brook a tributary to Parlin stream.
