AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Deer in Town of Swan's Island,
Hancock County, and to Provide for Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 82, amended. Section 82 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding after the 3rd paragraph thereof the following paragraph:

'There shall be a continual closed season on deer in the town of Swan's Island, located in the county of Hancock. The commissioner shall appoint no more than 10 wardens to enforce the inland fish and game laws in said Swan's Island. Such wardens shall serve without pay and shall furnish their own bonds.'
