STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Frankfort for Support of Lester Greenleaf.

Town of Frankfort; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$421 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Frankfort, to reimburse said town for supplies furnished to the family of Lester Greenleaf, state paupers; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

These supplies were furnished to the family of Lester Greenleaf before the family was taken over by the state.
