RESOLVE, in Favor of Daigle & Daigle of Fort Kent.

Daigle & Daigle; compensated. Resolved: That the sum of \$239.11 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Daigle & Daigle, of Fort Kent, to compensate them for burial expenses of Emile Lacombe; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve is to compensate the above undertakers for burial expenses of Emile Lacombe, a transient worker during potato digging time, from Canada, who was drowned. His family is destitute and live in the state of Maine. The town of St. John refused to pay this bill.
