## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Closed Time on Deer in Certain Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 82, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 82 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be an annual open season on deer during the month of November in each calendar year in the counties of Androscoggin, Cumberland, Hancock, Kennebee, Knox, Lincoln, Sagadahoe, Waldo, Washington and York. All the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be a closed season on deer.

There shall be an annual open season on deer in each calendar year beginning November 1 and ending December 15, both dates inclusive, in the counties of Androscoggin, Cumberland, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Sagadahoc and Waldo. All the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be a closed season on deer.'
