RESOLVE, Closing the Headwaters of Trout Brook and Its Tributaries in Townships 6-R-9, 5-R-9 and 4-R-9, in Piscataquis County, to Fishing.

Trout brook closed to fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to fishing, indefinitely, the headwaters of Trout brook and its tributaries in townships 6-R-9, 5-R-9 and 4-R-9, above the first bridge crossing Trout brook.
