IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Employment of Minors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 22, amended. Section 22 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'No male minor under 16 years of age and no female shall be employed in any of the above establishments between the hours of 12 midnight Saturday and 12 midnight Sunday in any one week.'
