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**AN ACT Relating to Restoration of Membership in Indian Tribes.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 330, amended.** The 1st sentence of section 330 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Any person a member of said tribe on March 22nd, 1901, as shown by the tribal census taken under the laws of the state, who shall have forfeited any rights of membership may regain said rights by petition, under oath, to the Indian agent, alleging ~~± year’s~~ **30 days**’ continuous residence within the state.’
