RESOLVE, Closing Farmer's Brook in Franklin County to Smelting.

Farmer's brook closed to smelting. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation to close Farmer's brook, so called, on the east shore of Varnum, in Franklin county, to smelting at all times.
