AN ACT Relating to Time for Registration of Voters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 3, § 41, amended. Section 41 of chapter 3 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 41. Registration in towns having 500 or more voters, and in small cities; changes in list may be made on election day.** In all towns, cities not included, having 500 or more registered voters, and in all cities having less than 3,000 inhabitants, the municipal officers shall receive applications of persons claiming a right to vote, on the 3 days, Sundays and court holidays excepted, next preceding the day of election, and on such additional days prior thereto as they may determine, and no application shall be received after the hour of 5 9 in the afternoon on the day next preceding the day of election, Sundays and court holidays excepted; and no names shall be added to the list of voters on the day of election, by certificate or otherwise, except such as were upon the list used at the last preceding election, and have been inadvertently omitted by the selectmen; and on that day no change shall be made in names except to correct clerical errors therein.'
