**AN ACT Providing for the Transfer of Persons Arrested on Certain
Capias Executions.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 153, § 63, amended. Section 63 of chapter 153 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting between the 2nd and 3rd sentences thereof a new sentence to read as follows:

'After his arrest the respondent shall be committed to the jail in the county from which the execution issued, or in case that county has no jail, he shall be committed to the jail in which the county having jurisdiction regularly keeps its prisoners; the expense of maintaining such prisoners shall be paid by the county having jurisdiction as in criminal cases.'
