Town of Springfield; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the town of Springfield from the general fund of the state the sum of \$2,000 for financial aid in the installation of toilet facilities in the town's consolidated school building.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1945, the town raised \$1,500 for this purpose and in 1946 the town raised \$400. There has been expended \$2,885 for drilling a well to supply water for the facilities and there is an overdraft of \$985. In order to complete the system it is necessary to raise an additional \$3,000 for plumbing and other expenses.

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
