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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Springfield.**

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**Town of Springfield; certain amounts charged off. Resolved:** That the state controller be, and hereby is, authorized to charge off the sum of \$2,118.33, now charged against the town of Springfield by the state for board and care of certain children.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

These children have a pauper settlement in Springfield and are in the custody of the state. The annual expense of these children to the town is at last \$1600 and since the town only has a population of 442 the expense is nearly prohibitive.
