AN ACT Permitting Refunds of Dog License Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 88, § 19, amended. Section 19 of chapter 88 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 19. Expenditure of money remaining in state treasury. All money received by the treasurer of state as provided in section 10 and remaining unexpended at the end of the fiscal year shall may be paid, if deemed advisable by the governor and council, to the several cities, towns and plantations in proportion to the amount each has paid into the state treasury under the provisions of sections 8 to 25, inclusive, and so much thereof as remains unexpended as aforesaid is appropriated to pay the same.'
