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**AN ACT Relating to the Supreme Court of Probate.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 140, § 32, amended.** Section 32 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

**'When, by reason of death, resignation or the removal of a guardian, and the appointment of another in his place from which an appeal to the supreme court of probate is taken, the judge may appoint a special guardian who shall have the same powers and perform the same duties as a guardian, until such appeal is disposed of and some guardian is appointed who may act legally.'**
