STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Registers of Probate in Foreign Estates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 42, amended. Section 42 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 42. Fees of registers in case of foreign estates. When administration is granted on the estate of a person not a resident of the state, or the will of such person is proved, or administration is granted to a public administrator, or a guardian is appointed for a non-resident minor, the register shall have a reasonable compensation shall be paid for the use of the county reasonable fees, to be fixed by the judge, for entering and filing the orders and decrees and for making the necessary records, to be paid by the executor, administrator, or guardian, and allowed to him in his account.'
