STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Clerks in the Office of Register of Deeds for York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, relating to clerk hire in the office of register of deeds in York county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$4,000 \$6,000, and such additional amount as may be authorized by the county commissioners;'
