STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Annual Audit of Towns Under Two Thousand Population.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 80, § 116, amended. Section 116 of chapter 80 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end of the 1st paragraph thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that towns with less than 2,000 population may, upon vote of the town, have the audit made by a duly elected town auditor.'
