STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Authorizing Towns to Expend Money on Cottage Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 80, § 91, amended. Section 91 of chapter 80 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 40 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Cities and towns may appropriate not over 25% of their summer road and bridge money, raised by such cities and towns, to be expended on lake or cottage roads, so called.'
