STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Obstructions of Snow and Ice on Traveled Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 124, § 23, amended. Section 23 of chapter 124 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 23. Placing obstructions on any traveled road; penalty. Whoever places rocks, stones, snow, ice or other obstructions in a traveled road, and leaves them there, shall be punished by a fine of \$1 for each offense, to be recovered on complaint, to the use of the town where the offense is committed.'
