# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

### AN ACT Relating to Rental of Armory in City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 12, § 24, amended. The 6th sentence of section 24 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'It shall be the duty of the commission to exercise general supervision and control over all armories, drill rooms, headquarters offices, stables, and state owned or controlled realty used for military purposes, to consult and cooperate with the municipal authorities and to devise effective means of obtaining and maintaining such armories, and to fix, subject to the approval of the governor, the compensation to be allowed to the municipalities as rent for them, except that such rent in the city of Lewiston shall be \$8,400 per year; they shall have the power, after consulting and hearing the responsible municipal officers, to determine the administrative question of military suitability and adequate maintenance of all armories, drill rooms, offices, headquarters offices, and stables, and it shall be their duty to notify the responsible officers of all deficiencies in these respects, and should such officers fail, refuse, or neglect to take effective measures for providing such suitable buildings and their maintenance, the chairman of the commission shall initiate the prosecution prescribed by section 25.'
