STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Appropriation for Seed Potato Board.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 127-F, repealed and replaced. Section 127-F of chapter 27 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 153 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 127-F. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$100,000 to be made available to the seed potato board, said sum so appropriated to be a revolving fund for the use of said board in carrying out the terms and purposes(as stipulated, herein.

Provided, however, that there shall be paid from tax collected under the provisions of sections 206 to 217, inclusive, of chapter 14, commonly known as the potato tax, \$10,000 each year for a period of 10 years, to the general fund of the treasury of the state in payment of said \$100,000 appropriation. The payments shall be made on the 30th day of June, 1947, and the 30th day of June, each year thereafter, until said \$100,000 has been paid. In the event of liquidation of the assets of the seed potato board at any time, the amount obtained from said liquidation shall be paid to the potato tax fund.'
