RESOLVE, Designating United Nations Day.

United Nations Day, designated. Resolved: That the Wednesday before the 3rd Tuesday of September of each year hereafter be, and hereby is, designated as United Nations Day in the state of Maine.

It shall be proper on this day for schools, colleges, civic and patriotic organizations to observe the significance of the United Nations in promoting world peace toward which objective so many citizens of this state made great sacrifices in the recent war; and to strengthen the United Nations through education to an understanding by all the people of its objectives and functions.
