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**AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Scallops in Certain Waters.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 34, § 108, amended.** Section 108 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that there shall be a perpetual open season for scallops in those waters beyond the following limits: beginning at Petit Manan bar to Schoodic point, to little Cranberry Island, to Duck Island, to Long Island, to whistle buoy at Johns Island, to Eastern Ear Isle au Haut to Saddle Back Light, to Green Island, Vinalhaven, to Twobush light, to Burnt Island light.'
