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**AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Judge and Recorder of the  
Millinocket Municipal Court.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1909, c. 393, § 15, amended.** Section 15 of chapter 393 of the private and special laws of 1909, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 15. Salaries of judge and recorder increased.** The judge shall receive a salary, in full for all services, of ~~\$1,500~~ \$1,650 per annum to be paid him by the county of Penobscot, and the recorder a salary of ~~\$900~~ \$1,000 per annum, payable quarterly, and such additional amount for clerk hire as may be authorized by the county commissioners.'
