AN ACT Relating to Suspension or Revocation of Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 57, § 60, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 60 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, to be lettered E, to read as follows:

‘E. Conviction of violation of any law relating to sale of intoxicating liquor to minors.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 57, § 60, sub-§ III, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection III of section 60 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘A. Conviction of violation of any law of this state or of the United States relating to the manufacture, possession, transportation or sale of intoxicating liquor, except sales to minors;’
