AN ACT Relating to Publication of Applications for Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 22-A, additional. Chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 22-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 22-A. Notice of application for license to be published. No new license for the sale of liquor shall be issued until notice of application for same has been published by the commission in the official state paper and a 10-day period has elapsed from the date of such publication.'
