STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Tenure of Office of State Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 3, amended. The 1st sentence of section 3 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The state liquor commission, as heretofore established, shall consist of 3 members to be appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the council, to serve for 3 years or during the pleasure of the governor and council.'
