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**AN ACT** Relating to Application of Penalty for Liquor Violation to  
Subsequently Issued Licenses.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 57, § 60, sub-§ IV, additional.** Section 60 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered IV, to read as follows:

**'IV. Whenever violations by licensees occur in one year's license period and remain undiscovered or carry over into the next license year pending investigation or final disposition either in criminal courts or before the commission, any license issued subsequent to violation for a new license year may be suspended or revoked by the commission.'**
