AN ACT Relating to Duties of Liquor Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 6, sub-§ XV, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection XV of section 6 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'The inspectors shall be under the direct supervision and control of the chief inspector. The chief inspector and inspectors shall act as the agents of the liquor commission for the proper enforcement of the liquor laws and shall promptly bring all violators of the liquor laws and the rules and regulations of the commission, who are licensees, before the commission for administrative action and shall inquire into all violations of the provisions of this chapter by all persons within the state; and for prosecuting offenders against the liquor laws shall have the same powers and duties throughout the state as sheriffs have in their respective counties.'
