STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Salary and Expense Account of Lieutenant-Governor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 11, § 1, amended. The last paragraph of section 1 of chapter 11 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘The governor and lieutenant-governor shall each receive an annual salary of \$5,000.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 11, § 2-A, additional. Chapter 11 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 2-A, to read as follows :

‘**Sec. 2-A. Lieutenant-governor’s expense account provided for.** There shall be established an account to be known as the “lieutenant-governor’s expense account” to which shall be credited such amounts as are appropriated by the legislature. This appropriation shall be available for expenditure by the lieutenant-governor at his discretion. This account shall not be subject to audit, except as to total amount to be paid.’

Sec. 3. Effective date. This act shall take effect only upon the adoption in September, 1947 of the proposed amendment to Article V, Part First,

of the constitution providing for the creation of the office of lieutenant-governor; and in case of such adoption shall take effect on the 1st Wednesday of January next succeeding the election of the lieutenant-governor.
