## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Width of Trucks Hauling Forest Products.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 19, § 85, amended.** The 1st sentence of section 85 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No motor vehicle or trailer which, with or without load, is wider than 8 feet over all, or is over 12 feet, 6 inches high, shall be operated on any way or bridge; except that trucks hauling firewood or pulpwood may be operated on any way or bridge if the width of the load does not exceed 8 feet, 6 inches.'
