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### **AN ACT to Permit Counties to Contribute for Advertising Resources.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 79, § 15-A, amended.** Section 15-A of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 238 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘**Sec. 15A. Appropriation for advertising in all counties.** ~~Aroostook county~~ All counties may expend not exceeding the sum of \$5,000 each, annually, under the direction of the county commissioners of ~~said each~~ county, and accounted for as other moneys of ~~said each~~ county, for advertising the natural resources, advantages and attractions of ~~said each~~ county.’
