# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT to Permit Counties to Contribute for Advertising Resources.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 15-A, amended. Section 15-A of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 238 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 15A. Appropriation for advertising in all counties. Areostock county All counties may expend not exceeding the sum of \$5,000 each, annually, under the direction of the county commissioners of said each county, and accounted for as other moneys of said each county, for advertising the natural resources, advantages and attractions of said each county.'
