RESOLVE, to Continue the Interim Commission to Study Methods to Assure Greater Productivity of the Forest Lands of the State.

Interim commission; continued. Resolved: That the interim commission to study methods to assure greater productivity of the forest lands of the state, as created by chapter 104 of the resolves of 1945, be and hereby is continued; and be it further

Resolved: That the sum of \$2,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state for all expenses necessarily incurred in carrying out the provisions of chapter 104 of the resolves of 1945.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In order to preserve the natural resources of the state it is necessary that a study be made so that proper conservation may be adopted.
