STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Qualifications of the Recorder of the Gardiner Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1911, c. 247, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 247 of the private and special laws of 1911 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The governor, by and with the consent of the council and upon the recommendation of the judge, shall appoint a recorder of said court, who shall reside in said Gardiner and who shall be an attorney at law.'
