STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Reimbursement to the Federal Government by Reason of Certain Recoveries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 272, amended. The last sentence of section 272 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'If the state participates in federal funds for the purposes of sections 256 to 274, inclusive, $\frac{1}{12}$ of the net of the amount collected from the estate of the beneficiary, with respect to old age assistance furnished him, a sum equal to the pro rata share to which the United States is equitably entitled shall be promptly paid by the treasurer of state to the United States as required by the laws of the United States.'
