Town of Palermo; money reallocated. Resolved: That the money appropriated in favor of the town of Palermo by the 92nd legislature for the repairing of the road beginning at state aid road and extending over Level Hill, so called, to state aid road at North Palermo be and hereby is reallocated to be expended during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1947 on repairing the road beginning at state aid road, No. 3, and extending through the valley to state aid road No. 2.
