RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Patten.

Town of Patten; money reallocated. Resolved: That the money appropriated in favor of the town of Patten by previous legislatures which was originally designated to be used at the foot of Ash Hill, near the turn of the Happy Corner road, so called, be and hereby is, reallocated to be expended in the ensuing years on state aid No. 4, known as the Happy Corner road.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Patten requests that the legislature transfer the special resolve funds amounting to \$1,405, which was to be used at the foot of Ash Hill, to state aid road No. 4.
